And in every true fairy tale, there comes a turning point: one (or more) of the protagonists decides to face the challenges and make a change through small everyday actions, alliances, and community initiatives.

JOIN US: HERE ARE SOME TIPS FOR SUBMITTING YOUR STORY

Story setting

Start from where you live: what are the challenges related to climate change? What are the struggles and progress of your generation?

Fantasy or reality?

The story can be of any genre: horror, fantasy, classic fairy tale, sci-fi, or adventure. You can also base it on a true story.

Characters

The characters can be human, non-human, alien—let your imagination run wild! Remember that stories often have recurring characters: the hero or heroine, villains, helpers, etc.

Story formats

- Written story (in any language)
- Comic strip
- Illustration
- Photo story



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WHO CAN PARTICIPATE AND HOW?

Anyone **under the age of 25** can participate.

Minors can take part with written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Individuals, schools, associations, youth centres, and informal groups are all welcome to join.
